



Call for Abstracts: Research for Sex Work 15: Resistance and Resilience

NSWP is seeking contributions that document and reflect on sex workers' resistance and resilience to various forms of oppression. Sex workers experience legal, social, and political oppression, and yet the global movement is thriving. The fight to end all forms of oppression and have sex work recognised as work is on-going. NSWP would like to showcase sex work resilience from the perspectives of sex workers, sex worker rights' activists, sex worker-led organisations and sex work programme implementers.

Research for Sex Work is a peer-reviewed international journal that incorporates community-led research and lived experiences, and reports on sex work within a rights-based framework.

NSWP welcome different types of articles, including community-led research findings and recommendations, narratives about rights-based sex work projects or programmes, and reflections on sex work and sex worker organising. Research for Sex Work aims to include articles from all regions.

NSWP is actively seeking contributions from sex worker-led organisations, and sex work organisations that use a rights-based framework, NGOs, research institutions that have worked in partnership with the sex worker community. Priority is given to submissions from sex workers and sex worker-led organisations.

The maximum length for the abstract is 300 words. Submissions must be in English but photographic montages that tell a story will also be considered. **The final article must be no longer than 1200 words**, the articles will be peer-reviewed and edited before publication.

Finished articles deadline: January 8, 2015 24:00 UCT. Authors must be accessible by email from January 8, 2015 to February 19, 2015 to revise articles in line with peer-reviewers comments and respond to questions from the editor. NSWP also request authors to submit high-resolution photos to accompany the article. To submit a photograph, you must own the rights to the photograph or have permission to reproduce it.
